Promoters are well Qualified Professionals having great experience in the field of education.

- The college publishes an annual Educational Journal with the Name Deen Dayal College, Journal of Education. It is primarily a Journal of Research in the field of education and is published to promote and continue the research culture amongst faculty members and post graduate students .
- B.Ed. department in the college is accredited by NAAC with B grade in 2012. The college has 200 approved seats in B.Ed. department from Session 2015-2016.

- The college is ISO 9000: 2001 certified institution. The college is well known in the region and popular for its quality education, best practices in research and disciplined environment.
- The students of Deen Dayal College have represented the nation on international stage. A student of department of Physical Education at Deen Dayal College won Gold Medal at Indo- Bhutan Taekwondo championship.

Contributions in the field of Education

Deen Dayal College has made significant contributions in the field of education through its Internal Quality assurance, self -evaluation mechanism, student centric learning and promotion of research.

Student-centred teaching methods shift the focus of activity from the teacher to the learners. The College practices student-centred learning, an approach to education focusing on the needs of the students. The college promotes the teaching methods such as active learning, cooperative learning, and inductive teaching and learning (i.e. inquiry-based learning, case-based instruction, problem-based learning, project-based learning, discovery learning, and just-in-time teaching). It promoted:

- Collaborative group learning, both inside and outside the classroom;
- Individual student research and discovery;
- Research and discovery by students and faculty together;

The following techniques are also used:

- Project based learning: Projects are assigned to the students, through which they come to know how to solve a particular problem and study that problem in-depth.

Students are provided knowledge by undertaking projects on different subject and on different topics of the same subject. This develops their analytical skills and provides confidence at the end of the day.

- Computer aided Instruction: Students are given computer aided instructions and encouraged to use latest technology. Students also have a compulsory subject. Basic knowledge of using computer is provided through a compulsory paper. On this they can build up when they start independent teaching jobs.
- Tutorial: Students attend one tutorial class per week. In tutorial classes, students are encouraged to speak at least for 5 minutes on important topics relevant to the field of education.
- Counselling is also provided.

The above mentioned methods contributed to self-management of knowledge and development of required skills.

- Reflective Teaching: Exploring our own classroom practice is an innovative practice that we propose to take up. Its details are as under:
- Reflective teaching is a process of self-observation and self-evaluation. By collecting information about what goes/went on in our classroom, and by analyzing and evaluating this information, we identify and explore our own practices and underlying beliefs. This leads to changes and improvements in our teaching.
- Research

Research is an integral part of B.Ed (more particularly M.Ed) programme. The college lays emphasis on the concept of promotion of research and on action research amongst the faculty (and student teachers).
- The College encourages higher education in the field of education by providing required relaxation and cooperation and motivates its teachers to take up research in education by deputing them to attend seminars and workshops, and undertake research studies.
- The faculty members doing research are given flexibility in the daily workload. Faculty of B.Ed. programme is motivated to contact and consult their counterpart in the M.Ed. programme.
- Visits to CCS University and other sister Institutions are encouraged for consulting the research-guides for research work / creative study.
- The college sponsors faculty member for paper presentation in seminars, reimburses the expenditure incurred by them and treats them on duty leave for which there is a standing provision in the College leave rules.
- National, international journals and magazines related to research are available in the library for reference. Research material is procured, if proposed by the researchers. Computer and internet facility are placed at their disposal.

Local Community Benifitted from DDC

The college contributes to the society through it's outreach activities as detailed hereunder

- Student and teachers visit the nearby villages every year and conducted community survey. They organize street plays on various social aspects like health awareness, education of girl child, prospects of education for development and also conducted sessions for guidance and counselling for unemployed people. Community Service helped in bringing community close to institute.
- Student teachers have done services to community by visiting aged citizens, and local village bodies and officials.

- By visiting community and spending some time with them, they tried to help them and educate them in their own way and shared some experiences with them.
- Pots, flower vase, jute bags, paintings made by students were distributed to schools and the community for use by their children.

The College would surely like to take up more initiatives in outreach programmes like:

- Planting the saplings in neighbored.
- Conducting ECO-Club activities frequently
- Engaging more students in working with NGO
- Providing basic computer education to every student as community service.
- Promoting cleanliness and sense of hygiene
- The institute proposes to organizing activities in collaboration with different social bodies like NGOs and GOs. It plans to organize blood donation camps in association with Indian Red Cross.

Local/indigenous traditional expertise will also be utilized in near future.

National level organizations

- The Institute has linkage with national level organizations like National Council of Education Research and Training & Indira Gandhi National Open University.
- Student teachers are sent on educational visits to NCERT and Kurukshetra University, Rajasthan Technical University, and CCS University.
- With such linkage the student teachers are immensely benefited.
- Exposure & knowledge as to the contribution of these National level organizations to the cause of education in general and to the Educational Training in particular, are immense.
- The Faculty members of CCS University are consulted for research work by the college's faculty member undertaking any research.
- The college has established linkages with IT companies for conducting Annual Workshop at the college wherein our teachers participate and make projects related to computer based teaching. Resource personnel from Multiple companies like Infosys, Brillio, IBM are to be invited for talks and one/Two days workshops are also to be organized. Tech Prudential, a franchise firm has been requested to organize two days workshop for the benefit of our faculty members and students.
- The College has excellent rapport with the schools wherein students are sent for teaching practice. In addition, the college remains in touch with other schools.
- Internship in reputed schools provides students with adequate exposure to get jobs of their satisfaction. Every year, students are absorbed by the schools, where the

students undergo internship even prior to the announcement of the final examination result.

- For effective implementation of Community Programmes, the college even gets help of the principals and the trustees of nearby schools. For the purpose, the institute deputed some teachers for delivering lectures to nearby schools whenever there is programme introduced by some reputed organizations. The college community and schools are thus creating networking for the common goals to be achieved.

a) **Faculty Development Programme & Research Cell:** The Cell was established by the Management to

promote research and empower the faculty by extending required facilities for attending seminars, etc. and organizing lectures for empowerment. It is composed of convenor, two members from the faculty and two experts. The function of this committee is to encourage the faculty and students for research work in different dimensions of education.

The cell meets twice a year.

b) **Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC):** IQAC is a Six-member forum that was established in 2009 to sensitize on and respond to the changing educational, social and market demands.

c) **Programme Advisory Committee (PAC):** The PAC is composed of Principal, two faculty members, two experts from outside, one principal of the neighbourhood school, one student and two representatives of the Alumni. Principal of the college heads the Cell.

PAC meets thrice in a year. (i) First meeting is held prior to the commencement of the Academic Session to formulate the academic calendar. (ii) The second meeting known as mid-term appraisal meeting, takes place in the middle of the academic session. (iii) The third meeting is held at the end of the session to take stock of all the developments that took place during the year.

d) **Sexual Harassment & Anti-Ragging Committee:** In the history of the college no incident of anti ragging or sexual harassment has ever surfaced. Vigil is tight and constant.

The committee meets twice a year. (i) First meeting is held prior to the commencement of the Academic Session to formulate the rules regarding the safety of the students. (ii). The second meeting is held at the end of the session to review the cases (if any) regarding the problems of the students. In between its patrolling unit does the work.

e) **Guidance and counselling Committee:** The Guidance and Counselling Committee is headed by a senior faculty. It organizes pre-practice teaching guidance and counselling services to the teacher trainees regarding their practice-teaching.

f) **Annual Calendar and Time Table Committee:** The committee develops time table and annual calendar on the basis of workload policy and curricular requirements and in the context of the university calendar.

The committee meets twice a year.

g) **Discipline Committee:** The discipline committee is composed of convenor and two faculty members. It is assigned the task of ensuring smooth functioning and maintaining discipline in the college.

The Committee meets thrice a year and as and when the situation demands. (i) First meeting is held prior to the commencement of the Academic Session to decide the distribution of duties & responsibilities to the faculty members for maintaining discipline. (ii) The second meeting takes place during mid-session to take actions, if so required. (iii) The third meeting is held at a suitable time to discuss and decide about the

discipline during conduct of tests and examination.

h) **Examination Committee:** It is composed of a convenor and two faculty members. The function of this committee is to take decision on activities related to examinations.

The present committee meets thrice a year. (i) First meeting is held prior to the commencement of the Academic Session for distribution of duties & responsibilities among the faculty members. (ii) The second meeting takes place before commencement of examinations. (iii) The third meeting is held as per need.

i) **Sports Committee:** Composed of convenor and four members, the committee plans and organizes sports activities and competition for physical development of the students.

Sports committee meets thrice a year (i) first meeting of sports committee is held in the beginning of the session for reviewing status of sports facilities, (ii) second meeting is held during mid-session for the organization of inter-house competition, and (iii) third meeting is held before the year-end examinations for the organization of sports week.

j) **Admissions Committee:** The committee is composed of convenor and two members from the faculty. The function of this committee is to facilitate and supervise the process of admissions.

Admissions committee meets thrice a year: (i) The first meeting of the committee is held before the process of admission starts at the university level, (ii) second meeting is held after the University advertisement appears in the media, and (iii) the third meeting is held before the process of admission starts at the level of college.

k) **Library Committee:** The Committee is composed of convenor and two members from the faculty and two student members. The function of this committee is to take care of the needs and functioning of the library.

Alumni Cell meets once a year generally in the last month of the academic year for getting feedback from alumni and for creating funds for scholarship and for awarding meritorious students.

p) **Placement Committee:** The placement Committee is composed of convenor and two members from the faculty. The function of this committee is to provide the placement services through counselling and maintaining record.

q) **Co-Curricular & Cultural Activity Committee:** The CCA is composed of convenor and two members each from the faculty and student community. The function of this committee is to plan, co-ordinate and organize co curricular activities.

CCA meets thrice a year. (i) First meeting is held prior to the commencement of the Academic Session, to select the convenor and members for committee. (ii) The second meeting takes place after the commencement of the session to decide about overall co-curricular activities to be held throughout the year. (iii) The third meeting is held to finalise matters concerning annual day.

r) **Purchase Committee:** The Purchase Committee is composed of convenor and two members from the faculty. The function of this committee is to decide the mode and manner of making purchases at competitive prices without compromising on quality, and ensuring that the supplied items meet the required specifications as ordered.

The committee meets on as and when required basis.

s) **Teachers Welfare Committee:** The teachers welfare Committee is composed of convenor and two members from the faculty. The function of this committee is to take decision related to the welfare of the faculty members.

t) **Students Council:** Students Council consists of two elected student representatives and a faculty member who acts as adviser –convenor. The council meets at least twice a year.

u) **Students Welfare Committee:** The Students Welfare Committee is composed of convenor and two members from the faculty and two student members. The function of this committee is to work for the welfare of the students.

Students welfare committee meets thrice a year. (i) First meeting is held soon after the commencement of the Academic Session. (ii) The second meeting takes place two months after the first meeting for identifying the needy students with a view to provide them with relevant help and for organizing blood camp to develop community sense among students. (iii) The third meeting is held in the month of February
